## SUNBIRD GOLF CLUB ADOPT A HOLE TASK LIST

The following is a list of the tasks that the Adopt A Hole volunteers are asked to do.

**Tee Boxes:** Basically this task is to clean up the tee boxes including filling divot holes with sand, picking up broken tees, emptying the broken tee boxes and picking up and disposing the large divot clumps. A leaf rake, if available, makes the task of cleaning up broken tees and divot clumps much easier especially on the par three boxes where there are many. When filling divot holes, the sand should be smoothed out to a level no higher than the surrounding grass. Cleaned up items may be disposed of in the waste baskets on the ball washers.

**Fairways:** This task is to walk the fairways and fill unfilled divot holes with sand. Again level the sand after filling.

Greens: This task involves repairing ball marks on the green.

**Other:** There may be times when Rick may ask the volunteers to do some other chores. These will be communicated as they occur.
