

Greens Committee meeting minutes

September 15, 2021 1:00 pm

Attending: Jack Cooper, Brendan Waddell, Laurie Moore, Kelly Davis, John Valentine, Julie Anderson

We opened the meeting with some questions about many things.

Large water pool on the left of the 4th fairway. Brendan says it is drying up.

Wet area beside the putting green. Lopez is working on it.

Weeds and grass issue. It is being mowed and cut as fast as they can and he is currently out of weed spray.

Fairway yardage poles need attention. They are being replaced.

Some uneven greens during cutting and it is being addressed.

#10 tee box...Railroad timbers, rock & edging removal. This will be addressed during overseed.

The new **Lift** for the maintenance building is expected any day.

Brendan plans to do some leveling of #11 tee box. As well as leveling some fairway bunker edges on #12 and letting them grow in with grass.

#12 lake needs to be dredged; Brendan suggested maybe a volunteer crew to maybe clean that out soon.

#17 flooding around Tee box. That is a sprinkler issue, no place for the water to go.

The greens will have a different blend of seed this year (Rye, Poi and Bent)

The "White Lines" across the fairway in front of the greens will begin after overseed.

Discussion on building the cover for the pumphouse and several of volunteered to help.

Julie Anderson attended to answer financial questions and stated board policy was that during June, July and August the Proshop received \$15 of every tournament entry fee per person and the rest of the year it is set at \$25. That is board approved policy.

Brendan provided answers and solutions to all the above questions and has plans to address them.

Brendan is also going to order some more **rakes**. He is also getting new **flags (red, white and blue)**. Julie stated he had about \$2000.00 in that account. Brendan has purchased new turf tires for the tractor. Palm tree trimming on the course will begin on Monday per Brendan.
